Today we will begin our theme on colors. Since we had a holiday last Monday and did not have Spanish class, I will reinforce Spanish numbers a little more today. The objects we will count today are felt balloons. Since the balloons are different colors, we will also talk about what colors they are. In addition, for the rest of the month I will ask each child what color his/her shirt is. I would like to try to focus on a few colors each week. Today we will focus on azul and rojo. Today's stamp: El globo rojo or azul/red or blue balloon (your child chooses the color.)
