**Spanish Vocabulary - Carol Nursery School**

As we continue learning our Spanish colors we will read Oso [marron], oso [marron] ¿qué ves ahí? This is Brown Bear, Brown Bear... by Eric Carle and Bill Martin Jr. This beloved book, also written in Spanish, is perfect for helping the kids review their colors. Before telling the children Spanish color word, I will reveal the animal asking if anyone remembers how to say its color in Spanish. Our song for today is "De colores", and we will dance with our scarves (I will help each child say the color he/she wants in Spanish) Today's stamp: la rana verde – the green frog. *Note: There are many ways to say brown in Spanish. I am teaching marrón. Café means brown and so does pardo. However, to keep things consistent, I will stick with marrón.*
